Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17, of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 441.

This bill increases the salaries of the supervisors of assessments in Calvert and St. Mary's Counties.

House Bill 531, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 24, 1973, generally provides for the State assumption of the property assessment function and the transfer of supervisors of assessments to State employment.

Specifically, Senate Bill 441 would place these supervisors in a salary grade that will not exist on July 1, 1973, the effective date of House Bill 531.

Because of the inconsistency between the two bills, Senate Bill 441 must be vetoed.
