profusely on this Pleasant Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, The County Commissioners of Calvert County were satisfied with the work of the Committee and so approved said design; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Calvert County, on August 1, 1954, designated such design as the official emblem of Calvert County; and

WHEREAS, It is now desirable to establish this emblem as the Official County Seal; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the General Assembly designate this county emblem as the Official County Seal; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Governor of Maryland be requested to issue a proclamation recognizing its adoption as the Official Seal of Calvert County; and be it further

RESOLVED, That copies of this Resolution be sent to the Governor, the County Commissioners of Calvert County, and the Calvert County Historical Society.

(Senate Joint Resolution 15)

A Senate Joint Resolution concerning

Ride a Bicycle Day in Maryland

FOR the purpose of requesting the Governor to declare the first Saturday in April of each year as Ride a Bicycle Day in Maryland.

WHEREAS, The use of bicycles for transporation and recreation is becoming increasingly popular and;

WHEREAS, The impending energy shortage has intensified the need to encourage self-powered forms of transportation of which the bicycle is one; and

WHEREAS, It is in the public's best interest that State and local governments encourage and promote bicycle riding as a form of outdoor exercise, recreation, sport and transportation that can be enjoyed by people of all ages; now, therefore, be it
