It is considered by the Justices here to wit at Kent County at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in August being the 13th day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty four that the said Joan Edwards to have at the whipping full fifteen lashes well laid on her bare back till the blood appear and also pay the sum of three hundred and fourteen pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the premises and to the officers of this Court

It is also considered by the Court here to wit the same day and year last mentioned that the Sheriff of Kent County take the said Joan Edwards to the whipping post and execute the punishment in the Indigent act specified and adjourn to bring her into Court again

The same Joan saith that she is big with child therefore the Court orders that the said cause be continued the same cause is by this Court continued for the executing the punishment in the Judgment act until the third Tuesday in November next being Court in course

ordered by this Court that soverely be given for the said Joan Edwards appearance at next Court to answer as act

Thereupon Daniel Dullahuntee of Kent County planter and present in Court in his proper person and act upon oaths himself indebted to the right honourable the Lord proprietor in the sum of three pounds current money of the Province of Maryland in the sum of three pounds current money to be made and body or his body goods and chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of the said Lord ship his heirs and successors conditionally that if the said Joan Edwards shall not make her personal appearance at the next Court to be held for Kent County on the third Tuesday in November next ensuing then to receive the punishment in the Judgment act specified and in the mean time she is to be of good behaviour — wherewith the same Daniel Dullahuntee acknowledges himself content
