CHAPTER 750

(House Bill 1046)

AN ACT concerning

Disability - Sheltered Workshop Employment

FOR the purpose of providing for the development of sheltered workshop employment by private nonprofit agencies for the benefit of severely disabled persons by contractual arrangement with the [[Division of Vocational Rehabilitation]] [[Mental Retardation Administration]] Division of Vocational Rehabilitation of the State Department of Education; defining terms; providing funding; providing for the control and conduct of the program; and generally relating to the employment of disabled persons.

[[SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Sections 38 through 44, inclusive, to be under the new subtitle "Sheltered Workshop Employment" be and they are hereby added to Article 59A - Mental Retardation, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1972 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) to read as follows:
