Item This Indenture Tripartite made the first day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and sixty eight Between Elisha Hall of Baltimore County and Mary his Wife of the one Part and John Wilmet of the second Part and Robert Alexander of Baltimore County of the third Part Witnesses that the said Elisha Hall and Mary his Wife for and in consideration of Five Shillings Sterling to them in hand paid by the said John Wilmet at or before the Ensealing and delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof the said Elisha Hall and Mary his Wife do and each of them doth Acknowledge and thereof and therefrom do and each of them doth hereby release Acquit and Discharge the said John Wilmet his Executors Administrators and Assigns Have and each of them hath Granted Bargained and sold and by these Presents do and each of them doth Grant Bargain and sell unto him the said John Wilmet his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns all that Lot of Land lying and being in the Addition to Baltimore Town known and distinguished by the Number forty one and also all that Lot of Land lying in the said Addition to Baltimore Town Number forty two being the Lot of Land whereon William Nicholson Deceased did live and also all that Part of a Tract or Parcel of Plantable Land lying in Baltimore County Originally called Loles (Harrow) but afterwards Resurveyed and called Todds Range which is contained within the following Meets and Bounds Courses and distances Viz: Beginning at the End of the North Seventeen Degree West fifty Perches line of that Part of the said Tract of Land sold by a certain Thomas High of Baltimore County to Joseph Banks and running thence and Bounds on the said Banks's Part South Seventeen degrees East thirty five Perches North forty Nine Degrees
