

(E) VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

(1) ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1977, ANY PERSON WHO OBTAINS A HUNTING LICENSE BY PRESENTING A [[FICTICIOUS]] FICTITIOUS CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY OR WHO ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY OR HUNTING LICENSE THROUGH FRAUD SHALL HAVE HIS HUNTING PRIVILEGES REVOKED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED ONE YEAR.

(2) ANY APPLICANT WHO IS REFUSED A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY UNDER THIS SECTION MAY APPEAL THE DECISION OR ACTION OF THE ISSUING AUTHORITY TO THE DEPARTMENT'S BOARD OF REVIEW.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 3 of Article 75 1/2 - Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
