A Senate Joint Resolution concerning

Maryland School For The Deaf

FOR the purpose of requesting the Governor to support the position of the Maryland School for the Deaf concerning certain staff positions and operating funds; and concerning the lifting of a certain "freeze" on faculty positions.

This Body has become increasingly aware of the growing need for adequate care and teaching of those of our citizens who, unfortunately, are deaf.

The Maryland School for the Deaf is in great need for six additional staff positions and \$2,500 worth of operating funds to accommodate growth and efficiency of the School for the Deaf.

Training and teaching of the deaf requires special skill, patience, and understanding. The growing number of the deaf increases the demand for competent teachers. Therefore, the Maryland School for the Deaf desires to "unfreeze" six vacant positions among the faculty for which funds have already been included within the 1977 fiscal year budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Governor be requested to seek to make provision for
