(E) ORGANIZATION FOR PARENTS OF HANDICAPPED CHILDREN — ONE MEMBER

~~(2) OF THE 24 MEMBERS INITIALLY APPOINTED TO THE COUNCIL, THE FIRST SEVEN APPOINTEES SHALL SERVE FOR ONE YEAR; THE SECOND SEVEN APPOINTEES, THREE OF WHOM SHALL BE FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND THE REMAINING FOUR MEMBERS SHALL BE THE APPOINTEES FROM SUBPARAGRAPH 160(A)(1)(IV), (V), AND (VI), SHALL SERVE FOR TWO YEARS; AND THE THIRD SEVEN APPOINTEES, ALL OF WHOM SHALL BE APPOINTEES FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC, SHALL SERVE FOR THREE YEARS. SUCCEEDING APPOINTMENTS SHALL BE FOR THREE YEARS. A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE FOR MORE THAN SIX YEARS. (2) OF THE 19 MEMBERS INITIALLY APPOINTED TO THE COUNCIL, THE APPOINTEES FROM SUBPARAGRAPH 160(A)(1)(I), (II), (III), (IV) AND (V) SHALL SERVE FOR ONE YEAR; THE APPOINTEES FROM SUBPARAGRAPH 160(A)(1)(VI), (VII), (VIII), AND THREE APPOINTEES FROM 160(A)(1)(IX) SHALL SERVE FOR TWO YEARS; AND THE REMAINING SIX APPOINTEES, ALL OF WHOM SHALL BE APPOINTEES FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC, SHALL SERVE FOR THREE YEARS. SUCCEEDING APPOINTMENTS SHALL BE FOR THREE YEARS. A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE FOR MORE THAN SIX YEARS.~~
