AN ORDINANCE to add new Sections 12-2300 through ~~12-2307~~ 12-2308, inclusive, to the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 12, "Licenses, Permits and Franchises", to follow immediately after Section 12-2209 thereof, and to be under the new Subtitle 23, "Facilities For The Disabled and Aged Persons", to require all shopping centers in excess of ~~five~~ TEN thousand square feet usable floor area to place or caused to be placed curb cuts, ramps, parking for handicapped or aged persons; to remove any barriers; to provide access to plumbing fixtures for such persons and to provide penalties for violations thereof, and matters generally related thereto.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to make an emergency appropriation from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the current fiscal year to the Office of the County Executive for the purpose of implementing the Criminal Justice Coordinator Program.
