SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

15-105.

(C) (1) EACH LICENSEE UNDER THIS TITLE SHALL MAINTAIN AND KEEP RECORDS ~~THAT THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES REQUIRED BY THIS ARTICLE.~~

(2) THE RECORDS SHALL BE KEPT FOR ~~AT LEAST~~ 3 YEARS AFTER THE TRANSACTION TO WHICH IT APPLIES.

(3) DURING BUSINESS HOURS, THE RECORDS OF THE LICENSEE SHALL BE OPEN TO INSPECTION BY THE ADMINISTRATION OR ANY POLICE OFFICER WHILE DISCHARGING HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES.

[(b) The dealer shall keep each record required by this section for at least 3 years from the date it was made.

[(c) During business hours, the dealer shall allow any representative of the administration and any police officer full access to the records required to be kept by this section.]

15-511.

[(c) During business hours, the records of the licensee shall be open for inspection by any police
