2300 VETOES

Further, there are specific benefits not currently available to full-time legislative employees that should be available to them since these benefits are available to the employees in the staff agencies. A few of these benefits have already been rejected when previous personnel practices were developed.

This legislation was meant to be remedial, correcting a bill which was passed during the 1978 session. The above-mentioned areas of concern, however, leave us no choice but to request that you veto House Bill 855.

House Bill No. 881

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City Jail

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the aggregate amount of \$1,250,000 \$1,000,000, the proceeds to be used for the acquisition, construction, or renovation of work release centers for the purpose of housing certain Baltimore—City Jail residents in work release programs; renovation and conversion of the existing City Jail Food Service Building into a vocational/educational training center and dormitory; funds to complete construction of the new City Jail kitchen to comply with standards of the State Health Department and State Jail Inspector; subject to the requirement that Baltimore City provide at least an equal and matching sum amount for the same purpose; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
