CHARTER 1978-1

RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Council of The Town of New Windsor adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 edition, as amended and replaced), title "Corporations - Municipal", subtitle "Home Rule", to amend the municipal Charter of The Town of New Windsor by repealing and reenacting with amendments Section 11-12 - Ordinances - of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1976 Edition) to change the publication of each ordinance so that a fair summary thereof is published in a newspaper rather than the entire ordinance being so published and, in addition thereto, complete and exact copies of the ordinance are to be posted in both the Town Office and the Post Office in New Windsor not less than sixty (60) days after its enactment.
