

Annotated Code of Maryland
(1976 Replacement Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 15A - Budget and Fiscal Planning

29.

(A) (1) THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "DIRECT AND INDIRECT PERSONNEL COSTS" MEANS ALL PAYMENTS MADE OR LIABILITIES INCURRED WITH RESPECT TO THE COMPENSATION OF PERSONNEL. THE TERM INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, WAGES, SALARY, WAGE OR SALARY ADJUSTMENTS, EMPLOYMENT TAXES, INSURANCE PAYMENTS, FRINGE BENEFITS, AND PENSION CONTRIBUTIONS.

~~(3) "FEDERAL-FUND-APPROPRIATIONS", "SPECIAL-FUND-APPROPRIATIONS", AND "GENERAL-FUND-APPROPRIATIONS" MEAN THOSE FUNDS AND APPROPRIATIONS DESIGNATED AS SUCH IN THE BUDGET BILL.~~

(4) (3) "UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL" MEANS THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND HOSPITAL IN BALTIMORE CITY.

(B) IN THE BUDGET BILL FOR FISCAL YEAR 1982 AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL CHARGE INCLUDE ALL DIRECT AND INDIRECT PERSONNEL COSTS OF UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL ~~TO THE SPECIAL-FUND AND FEDERAL-FUND-APPROPRIATIONS FOR UNIVERSITY-HOSPITAL, DIRECT AND INDIRECT PERSONNEL COSTS FOR UNIVERSITY-HOSPITAL MAY NOT BE CHARGED TO GENERAL-FUND APPROPRIATIONS~~ IN THE BUDGET FOR UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL.

(C) IN THE CASE OF PERSONNEL EMPLOYED BY UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL AND ANOTHER STATE AGENCY, THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT PERSONNEL COSTS SHALL BE PRORATED, AND THAT PORTION ALLOCABLE TO UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL SHALL BE APPROPRIATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
