In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the  
Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 553.This bill expands existing District Court injunction  
authority to include enforcement of electrical and plumbing  
code violations.House Bill 772, which was enacted by the General  
Assembly and signed by me on April 22, 1980, accomplishes  
the same purpose.Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill
