(B) SEPARATE OFFENSE FOR EACH DAY.

EACH DAY THAT A Violation-occurs--is PERSON PRACTICES WELL DRILLING WITHOUT A LICENSE CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE OFFENSE.

21-601. SHORT TITLE.

21-602. TERMINATION OF TITLE.

SUBJECT TO THE REGULATORY PROGRAMS EVALUATION ACT OF 1978, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE AND ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE CREATING THE STATE BOARD OF WELL DRILLERS AND RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF WELL DRILLERS ARE OF NO EFFECT AND MAY NOT BE ENFORCED AFTER JULY 1, 1987.
