

(3) Sheltering persons during an emergency [or major disaster].

(c) This section applies only to injuries to person or property incurred on or adjacent to the premises:

(1) During an actual or practice attack or raid;

(2) While supplies and materials are being moved or stored;

(3) During an emergency [or major disaster]; or

(4) During inspections or visits connected with EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND civil defense [and disaster preparedness].

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

(House Bill 751)

AN ACT concerning

Purchases for Minority Businesses - Fraud

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter 775 of the Acts of the General
