

(A) IN GENERAL.

TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(B) MORAL CHARACTER.

THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER.

(C) AGE.

THE APPLICANT SHALL BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD.

(D) EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE -- OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST LICENSE.

AN APPLICANT FOR AN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST LICENSE SHALL HAVE COMPLETED SUCCESSFULLY:

(1) THE ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS OF AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM IN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY THAT:

(I) IS RECOGNIZED BY THE BOARD AND ACCREDITED BY THE AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION IN COLLABORATION WITH THE AMERICAN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION; AND

(II) IS CONCENTRATED IN:

1. BIOLOGICAL OR PHYSICAL SCIENCE;
2. PSYCHOLOGY;
3. SOCIOLOGY; AND
4. SELECTED TREATMENT MODALITIES;

AND

(2) AT LEAST 6 MONTHS OF SUPERVISED, FULL-TIME FIELD WORK EXPERIENCE AT A RECOGNIZED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OR IN A TRAINING PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION WHERE THE APPLICANT MET THE ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS.

(E) SAME -- OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT LICENSE.

AN APPLICANT FOR AN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT LICENSE SHALL HAVE COMPLETED SUCCESSFULLY:

(1) THE ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS OF AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM FOR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANTS THAT IS RECOGNIZED BY THE BOARD AND APPROVED BY THE AMERICAN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION; AND

(2) AT LEAST 2 MONTHS OF SUPERVISED, FULL-TIME FIELD WORK EXPERIENCE AT A RECOGNIZED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OR IN A TRAINING PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE
