

(1) COMPENSATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET; AND

(2) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(D) STAFF.

THE BOARD MAY EMPLOY A STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

15-205. MISCELLANEOUS POWERS AND DUTIES.

(A) POWERS.

IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS TITLE, THE BOARD MAY:

(1) ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE; AND

(2) ISSUE SUBPOENAS AND ADMINISTER OATHS IN CONNECTION WITH:

(I) ANY INVESTIGATION UNDER § 15-312 OF THIS TITLE; OR

(II) ANY HEARING UNDER § 15-313 OF THIS TITLE.

(B) DUTIES.

IN ADDITION TO THE DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS TITLE, THE BOARD SHALL:

(1) KEEP A COMPLETE RECORD OF ALL ITS TRANSACTIONS; AND
