CHAPTER 23

(House Bill 418)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Department of Agriculture - Ginseng Control

FOR the purpose of providing for the regulation and conservation of ginseng plants; providing a definition; requiring certain persons to hold a permit or register with the Maryland Department of Agriculture and to maintain certain records; authorizing the imposition of certain permit or registration fees and the establishment of a certain fund for administration of ginseng regulatory and conservation programs; and making this Act an emergency measure.
