- (e) The several committees shall submit reports to the Caroline County Planning Commission in those instances in which the committees' work or observations relate to the functions of planning and zoning.
- (f) The Board of County Commissioner may appropriate public funds to implement and support the powers and duties provided in this section.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 183

(House Bill 613)

AN ACT concerning

Estates and Trusts - Commissions

FOR the purpose of altering a provision with regard to the value of amounts on which certain trustees may, under certain circumstances, use a schedule of increased rates of income and corpus commissions; and correcting an error.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article - Estates and Trusts

14-103.

(a) (1) A testamentary trustee and trustee of any other trust whose duties comprise the collection and distribution of income from property held under a trust agreement or the preservation and distribution of the property are entitled to commissions provided for in this section for their services in administering the trusts.
