

to assist State and local fire service and law enforcement personnel in arson prevention, detection, and control;

(d) The adequacy of the methods used in the collection of arson data in Maryland, including the availability of information systems used to predict incidents of arson;

(e) The existence of State and local laws, programs or practices, which may have the inadvertent effect of contribution to arson, including those related to insurance and housing;

(f) The existence of institutional impediments with in State and local government to effective arson prevention, detection, and control;

(g) Strategies for the identification and counseling of juveniles impelled to commit arson, including a program for training juvenile counselors; and

(h) Public education or community programs on the extent, causes, and prevention of arson.
