CHAPTER 620

(House Bill 654)

AN ACT concerning

St. Mary's County - Sedimentation Control Ordinance
and Enforcement

FOR the purpose of providing that St. Mary's County Commissioners may adopt rules and regulations for sedimentation control; providing that St. Mary's County Commissioners may provide for enforcement of sedimentation control; providing that violations of sedimentation control ordinances are misdemeanors; providing that the County Commissioners may establish civil penalties for violations; requiring that a citation given to a person believed to have violated the sedimentation control ordinance or regulation contain certain information; providing for a maximum fine; providing that a person who receives a citation has a right to trial in district court if notice of such intention is filed by a certain date; providing that fines collected by the district court for violations of the sedimentation control ordinance shall be remitted to the county; providing that St. Mary's County has ex parte injunctive relief against a violator; and generally relating to sedimentation control and enforcement in St. Mary's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

10J.

(A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR ST. MARY'S COUNTY MAY:

(1) ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR EROSION AND SILTATION CONTROL REQUIREMENTS TO FACILITATE SEDIMENTATION CONTROL WITHIN THE COUNTY; AND
