

(7) The release of these inmates would not be contrary to the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HARRY HUGHES, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, having thought proper the extension of clemency in the following cases do hereby pursuant to the authority vested in me by law, grant unto the following persons a COMMUTATION of the remainder of their sentences as imposed for the offenses indicated:
