

(c) The organization, corporation, or volunteer fire company desiring to conduct or operate a game of bingo under the provisions of this section shall first obtain a permit therefor from the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County and shall pay a fee to be determined by the Board of County Commissioners to defray the cost of issuing such a permit.

(d) No such bingo game shall award a cash prize in excess of [twenty dollars (\$20.00)] \$50 to any player of a bingo game, except that the award of a "jackpot" in an amount not to exceed [three hundred dollars (\$300.00)] \$500 is allowed when directly connected with the playing of bingo games.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
