(C) THE TASK FORCE INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

(1) ONE MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE; AND

(2) ONE MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE.

[(c)] (D) The members of the Task Force shall elect the chairman and vice-chairman from among the Task Force's members.

(E) (1) IF A MEMBER OF THE TASK FORCE IS ABSENT FROM TWO OR MORE MEETINGS OF THE TASK FORCE, THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE THAT MEMBER AND APPOINT ANOTHER MEMBER TO THAT SEAT.

(2) A MEMBER MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED ABSENT FROM A MEETING OF THE TASK FORCE IF:

(I) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE TASK FORCE HAS EXCUSED THE MEMBER'S ABSENCE IN ADVANCE OF THE MEETING; OR

(II) ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL DESIGNATED BY THE MEMBER REPRESENTS THE MEMBER AT THE MEETING.

[(d)] ~~(E)~~ (F) The Mental Hygiene Administration and the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration shall provide staff for the Task Force.

[(e)] ~~(F)~~ (G) A member of the Task Force:

(1) may not receive compensation; but

(2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

[(f)] ~~(G)~~ (H) The Task Force shall:

(1) identify and recommend creative ways to provide and deliver comprehensive, integrated, cost-effective services to the population with co-occurring mental [illness] HEALTH and substance [abuse] USE disorders;

(2) identify and recommend various methods of funding services through private and public sources;
