

notwithstanding Section 5-302(e) of the Education Article or any other provision of law, the Interagency Committee on School Construction shall, in accordance with the provisions below, allocate 100% of the funds available for public school construction projects in fiscal year 2006. The Interagency Committee on School Construction shall include funds available in the contingency fund established in Section 5-301 of the Education Article in the allocations. The allocations made by the Interagency Committee on School Construction for fiscal year 2006 shall not be subject to approval by the Board of Public Works.

Further provided that the following amounts approved for public school construction projects by the Board of Public Works on January 19, 2005, and February 16, 2005, shall be allocated to each county:
