

this Act, and the Treasurer of the State is hereby authorized under the direction of the Governor to invest in the bonds to be issued as aforesaid, one million of dollars of the interest of the Sinking Fund or any other fund in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, and that all payments made by or on account of the purchasers of the bonds or certificates of debt issued under the provisions of this bill, shall be made to the Treasurer on the warrant of the Comptroller, and all certificates of debt or bonds so issued shall be signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by the Comptroller.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That the special tax of ten cents on the hundred dollars authorized by the fifth section of the Act of January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter fifteen, shall continue to be levied as therein provided, to meet the interest and create a Sinking Fund for the redemption of the bonds or certificates of debts herein directed to be issued, and the tax shall be annually levied, collected and paid over, as the other State taxes are levied, collected and paid over to the State Treasury, until the debt created by this Act, and by the said Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, shall have been paid, and a separate and distinct account shall be kept thereof, and the proceeds thereof are hereby pledged to the payment of the principal and interest of the said bonds or certificates issued under this Act or said Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four.

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That no further certificates of indebtedness under the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter fifteen, shall be issued, and whatever bounties or arrearages of bounty still remain to be paid, under the provisions of that Act, shall be paid out of the proceeds of the loan hereby authorized.

Sec. 7. And be it further enacted, That the Mayor and City Council of the city of Baltimore, and the County Commissioners of the several counties, be and are hereby authorized to raise by loan or otherwise such sum or sums as may be necessary to pay to each volunteer or drafted man, or person furnishing a representative substitute, or his authorized agent or attorney, the sum of two hundred dollars in addition to the State bounty as provided for in the previous sections of this Act, for the purpose of filling the quota of the several counties and of the city of Baltimore, under the call of the President of the United States for three hundred thousand men, dated December, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, or any other similar one which shall hereafter be made.

Sec. 8. And be it further enacted, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and the County Commissioners of the several counties aforesaid, are hereby prohibited from
