

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following bills :

A bill entitled, an Act to amend an Act passed at the January session, 1864, chapter 137, entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 25 of the 38th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, "Fees of Officers," and relating to the fees of Notaries Public ;

Also, a bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the electors of President and Vice President of the United States in and for the State of Maryland, their officers and attendants ;
