We beg leave to renew the recommendation made in our last report in regard to shortening the terms of convicts, for good behavior, and also for removing from the Institution those who are insane and idiotic.

We ask your favorable consideration of the reports of the Warden and Physician.

It is not intended to ask any appropriation of the Legislature the present year, as it is believed its receipts will be sufficient from ordinary sources to cover its expenses.
