

On motion of Mr. Donaldson,

Ordered, That the Comptroller report to this House as soon as possible, a statement of the receipts and disbursements of the Treasury, during the fiscal year ending the 30th of September last, giving the items in the manner adopted in the Annual Report; and that he also report the balance in the Treasury at the present time.

On motion of Mr. Matthews,

Ordered, That the Speaker appoint a special committee of five to report to the House, the cost, outlay and expenditure of the Special Session of the General Assembly for the year 1861; during the months of April, May, &c.

The Speaker appointed Messrs. Matthews, Reese, Creswell, Thomas and White, said committee.

On motion of Mr. Herbert,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary; to introduce a bill, amendatory to the act passed 10th day of May 1861, known as the Stay Law.

Mr. Phelps, from a select committee made the following report:

The Committee appointed to report rules for the regulation of this House, beg leave to report the rules adopted by the last House of Delegates without amendment;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Price, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported a bill entitled, An act to authorize the sale or mortgage of certain real estate devised by the will of Solomon Betts, deceased;

Which was read the first time.

The Secretary of the Senate returned the following:

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the Commissioners of Montgomery county to raise moneu for the purpose of building a jail;

Endorsed "passed by yeas and nays."

Mr. Bowie, from the Prince George's county delegation, reported a bill entitled, An act to authorize the Governor to issue commissions to the several persons who shall appear to have been elected justices of the peace and constables in the several election districts of Prince George's county, from a copy of the poll books duly certified by the clerk of said county under his seal of office;
