

(2) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves only for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(3)--A- EXCEPT FOR THE STUDENT MEMBER, A member may be reappointed but may not serve more than two full 5-year terms. THE STUDENT MAY BE REAPPOINTED IF THAT STUDENT CONTINUES AS CHAIRPERSON OF THE STUDENT ADVISORY ASSEMBLY TO THE STATE BOARD.
