CHAPTER 327

(Senate Bill 298)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Talbot County Jail

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$100,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Talbot County Council for the purpose of the study and planning of a county jail, subject to the condition that the Talbot-Geunty-Geunty County Council of Talbot County provide a matching fund of a certain type and amount for the same purpose by a certain date; providing that certain easements be granted to the Maryland Historical Trust; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Talbot County Jail Loan of 1984 in the aggregate principal amount of \$100,000. This loan shall be
