AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Alcoholic Beverages - Employment of Minors

~~FOR--the--purpose--of--prohibiting--a--person--under--a--certain--age--in--Cecil--County--from--being--employed--to--sell,--serve,--deliver,--or--otherwise--deal--with--alcoholic--beverages--~~

FOR the purpose of providing that in Cecil County, an alcoholic beverages licensee may employ a person 18 years of age or older to sell, serve, deliver, or otherwise deal with alcoholic beverages; and providing for a delayed effective date.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
