

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "COMMISSION" MEANS THE SPECIAL ADVISORY COMMISSION ON PROFESSIONAL SPORTS AND THE ECONOMY.

THERE IS A SPECIAL ADVISORY COMMISSION ON PROFESSIONAL SPORTS AND THE ECONOMY.

553.

(A) (1) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF 13 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

(2) OF THE 13 COMMISSION MEMBERS:

(I) 3 SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVES OF PROFESSIONAL SPORTS IN THE STATE;

(II) 3 SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVES OF STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT;

(III) 3 SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;

(IV) 2 SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, SELECTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE; AND

(V) 2 SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, SELECTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.

(B) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON JULY 1, 1985.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
