SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984 and shall be void and of no effect after September 30, 1984.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 438

(House Bill 697)

AN ACT concerning

State Employees - Health Insurance Program - Open Enrollment - Nonparticipating Surviving Spouses

FOR the purpose of requiring that the State Employees' Health Insurance Program provide continuous open enrollment for nonparticipating State employees under certain circumstances; providing that evidence of insurability may not be required if the State employee was previously covered under another group health insurance policy; and generally relating to the State Employees' Health Insurance Program.

BY adding to

Article 64A - Merit System Section 48B Annotated Code of Maryland (1983 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 64A - Merit System

48B.

- (A) THE STATE EMPLOYEES' HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE CONTINUOUS OPEN ENROLLMENT FOR ANY NONPARTICIPATING STATE EMPLOYEE WHO IS THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS NOT A STATE EMPLOYEE.
- (B) EVIDENCE OF INSURABILITY MAY NOT BE REQUIRED IF THE SURVIVING SPOUSE WAS PREVIOUSLY COVERED UNDER A GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY.
