CHAPTER 739

(Senate Bill 426)

AN ACT concerning

Unemployment Insurance Law - Amateur Sports Officials

FOR the purpose of excluding from the definition of employment under the State Unemployment Insurance Law any service performed in an amateur athletic contest by a referee, umpire, linesman, or other official on a per game fee basis for ~~a nonprofit~~ an association of referees, umpires, linesmen, or other officials, if the performing official is made aware and understands before performing the service that the service is not covered employment ; and providing for the retroactive application of this Act.
