

(3) MAKE AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR, THE TREASURER AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1312(B) OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY REGARDING THE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS DURING THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR, PLANS FOR DISBURSEMENT DURING THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR, AND ANY PLANS FOR FUTURE DISBURSEMENT;

(4) MEET AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THE BOARD DETERMINES, SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 41, § 14 OF THE CODE;

(5) CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARINGS AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR AT TIMES AND PLACES THE BOARD DETERMINES;

(6) DESIGNATE PERSONS TO STAFF THE BOARD EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENTS REPRESENTED ON THE BOARD; AND

(7) PERFORM OTHER DUTIES ASSIGNED TO IT BY THIS SUBTITLE.

(A) FUNDS IN THE TRUST FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES, SUBJECT TO ANY RESTRICTIONS ON THEIR USE OR OTHER LIMITATIONS ON ALLOCATION EXPRESSLY PROVIDED BY STATUTE OR REQUIRED AS A CONDITION OF ACCEPTANCE:

(1) IN THE CASE OF REFUNDS RECEIVED BY THE STATE FROM ANY SOURCE, INCLUDING AS A DIRECT OR INDIRECT RESULT OF ALLEGED PETROLEUM PRICING VIOLATIONS:

(I) FOR EMERGENCY ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROVIDED UNDER ARTICLE 41, § 495(1) OF THE CODE;

(II) FOR WEATHERIZATION PROGRAMS PROVIDED UNDER ARTICLE 41, § 495(2) OF THE CODE;

(III) FOR ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS PROVIDED UNDER ARTICLE 41, § 495(3) OF THE CODE;

(IV) FOR ENERGY ASSISTANCE AND WEATHERIZATION PROGRAMS PROVIDED UNDER ARTICLE 41, § 205G OF THE CODE;

(V) FOR ENERGY EXTENSION SERVICE PROGRAMS PROVIDED UNDER 42 U.S.C. §§ 8621-8629;

(VI) FOR OTHER ENERGY ASSISTANCE OR WEATHERIZATION PROGRAMS MEETING THE RESTITUTIVE OBJECTIVES GOVERNING THE DISTRIBUTION OF OVERCHARGE REFUNDS TO THE STATES; AND

(VII) FOR ANY OTHER PROGRAM WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF "ENERGY CONSERVATION PROGRAMS" AS PROVIDED BY PUB. L. NO. 97-377, 96 STAT. 1830, § 155 (1982).
