

any person for tortious conduct arising from the charge. With respect to subsection (a)(7), the petition may not be filed earlier than 5 years nor later than 10 years after the pardon was signed by the Governor.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
