

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(E-1) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL:

(1) EMPLOY 18 PERMANENT PART-TIME INSPECTORS;
