(f) The boards of county commissioners of Allegany, Carroll, and Charles counties are hereby respectively authorized and empowered to appoint dog wardens, in their respective counties, who shall have all the powers of a constable or other peace officer and who may sell and issue dog licenses, and take into custody and dispose of stray, injured and sick dogs in accordance with rules, regulations or resolutions of the respective board of county commissioners enacted pursuant to [paragraph] SUBSECTION (e) hereof.
