- (A) UNLESS--AUTHORIZED--TO--PRACTICE--DIETETICS EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED UNDER THIS TITLE, A PERSON MAY NOT REPRESENT OR IMPLY TO THE PUBLIC BY USE OF THE TITLE "LICENSED DIETITIAN", BY OTHER TITLE, BY DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES, METHODS, OR PROCEDURES, OR--OTHERWISE, THAT THE PERSON IS AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE DIETETICS IN THE STATE.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 4.5-401 OR § 4.5-402 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

SUBTITLE 5. SHORT TITLE; TERMINATION OF TITLE

4.5-501.

THIS TITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE "MARYLAND DIETITIANS ACT".

4.5 - 502.

SUBJECT TO THE EVALUATION AND REESTABLISHMENT PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND PROGRAM EVALUATION ACT, THIS TITLE AND ALL REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE SHALL TERMINATE AND BE OF NO EFFECT AFTER JULY 1, 1995.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the requirements for licensure of dietitians established by this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
