(6) The Maryland Independent College and University Association; and

(7) The State Board for Higher Education; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Governor is requested to provide appropriate staff resources to serve the Commission; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Commission make an interim report to the Governor and the General Assembly by November 18, 1985; and a final report by July 1, 1986; and be it further
