- 2. THE STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION WITH APPROVED PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT PROGRAMS.
- (II) APPOINT THE CONSUMER MEMBER SELECTED BY THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE:
 - (5) THE CONSUMER MEMBER:
 - (I) SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;
- (II) MAY NOT BE A PHYSICIAN, FORMER PHYSICIAN, PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT, OR A PERSON IN TRAINING TO BECOME A PHYSICIAN OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT;
- (III) MAY NOT HAVE A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER WHO IS A PHYSICIAN OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT, OR A PERSON IN TRAINING TO BECOME A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT; AND
- APPOINTMENT A SUBSTANTIAL FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A PROCESS REGULATED BY THE BOARD.
- (6) EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THE STATE.
- (B) THE PHYSICIAN AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL:
- (1) (I) BE LICENSED AS A PHYSICIAN UNDER TITLE 14 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR
- (II) BE CERTIFIED AS A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT UNDER THIS TITLE; AND
- (2) HAVE SUPERVISED PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT PRACTICES.

THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS GOVERNING:

- (1) THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR COMMITTEE MEMBERS;
- COMMITTEE; (2) THE PROCEDURE FOR FILLING VACANCIES ON THE
- (3) THE APPOINTMENT OF A CHAIRPERSON AND OTHER OFFICERS FOR THE COMMITTEE; AND
 - (4) THE REMOVAL OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS.

FUNDS FOR COMPENSATION, EXPENSES, AND STAFF FOR THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO THE BOARD IN THE STATE BUDGET.
