

CHAPTER 850

(Senate Bill 1047)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Special Registrations

FOR the purpose of authorizing an owner of certain vehicles to apply to the Motor Vehicle Administration for the assignment of certain special registration plates if a certain lessee, or director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity is a member of certain organizations; and generally relating to an authorization of the assignment of special registration plates if a certain lessee, or director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity is a member of certain organizations.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

13-614.

(a) (1) ~~The owner of any vehicle described in paragraph (2) of this subsection~~ A VEHICLE, OR A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE UNDER A LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, OR A DIRECTOR, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR PARTNER OF A BUSINESS ENTITY THAT OWNS THE VEHICLE may apply to the Administration for the assignment to that vehicle of a special, veterans' organization registration number, if:
