and appreciated and where silence in the face of deliberate acts of wanton hatred cannot and must not be tolerated in this State"; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Governor is requested to establish a task force to study, develop, and implement methods for dealing with incidences of racial and other forms of hatred in the public schools of this State; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force gather information to determine whether-the-State-Human-Relations-Gommission-should have the appropriate agency to have jurisdiction to deal with the type-of-discrimination-that-currently-plagues this recurrent discrimination in the public schools of this State; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force be composed of:

- (1) One member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate; and
- (2) Representatives from the State Board of Education, the State Human Relations Commission, the Office for Children and Youth, the Office of Minority Affairs, and the Office for Handicapped Individuals; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Governor designate the chair of the task force; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force report its <u>interim</u> findings and recommendations to the General Assembly by December - 1, -1986 January 15, 1987, and issue its final report by October 1, 1987; and be it further

RESOLVED, That staff for the task force be provided by the State Department of Education; and be it further
