- (1) Compensation in accordance with the State budget unless the member otherwise is a public official; and
- (2) Reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- (c) (1) With the approval of the Secretary, the Board may employ a Board secretary and other staff.
- (2) The Board secretary and other staff are entitled to compensation in accordance with the State budget.

- (a) In addition to the powers set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board may adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this title.
- (b) In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board shall:
 - (1) Carry out the provisions of this title;
- (2) Review and comment on proposed rules and regulations that relate to well system equipment and the construction of wells that are submitted to it before adoption by the Secretary;
- (3) Collect and account for any funds received under this title;
 - (4) Keep a record of:
 - (i) Each license that it issues; and
- (ii) Each action it takes under § [21-310] 13-310 of this title;
- (5) Require any person who practices well drilling to be covered in accordance with its rules and regulations by a reasonable performance bond and reasonable contractor's liability insurance; and
 - (6) Have an official seal.

- (a) Except for the fees specifically set by this title, the Board may set reasonable fees for the issuance and renewal of licenses and its other services.
- (b) The Board shall pay any fee collected under this title into the General Fund of the State.
