- (4) A member of the Maryland-District of Columbia AFL-CIO;
- (5) A member of the national AFL-CIO;
- (6) A member of the Maryland Committee for Occupational Safety and Health;
- (7) A member of the Maryland Conservation Council;
- (8) 2 members of the State Senate;
- (9) 2 members of the State House of Delegates;
- (10) A representative of the Maryland Department of [Health and Mental Hygiene] THE ENVIRONMENT;
- (11) A representative of the Maryland Commissioner of Labor and Industry;
- (12) A member of the Maryland Council on Toxic Substances;
- (13) A member of the Maryland Occupational Safety and Health Advisory Board;
- (14) 2 representatives of local fire departments;
- (15) 2 representatives of a local political subdivision, 1 of whom shall be a representative of a municipality;
- (16) A representative of the Chemical Manufacturer's Association;
- (17) 3 members of the Maryland Chamber of Commerce;
- (18) A representative of a major medical institution in the State; and
- (19) An ex officio, nonvoting representative of the State Law Department.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 8-1105.2 and 8-1105.3, respectively, of Article - Natural Resources of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 8-1103 and 8-1104, respectively.
