- (a) The State Treasurer is responsible for the management of funds in the Trust Fund and shall manage those funds under the authority granted in §§ 6-222 and 6-223 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- (b) The State Treasurer shall make an annual report to the Board of Trustees, to the Governor, and, in accordance with § 2-1312(b) of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly concerning the management of the funds in the preceding fiscal year.
- (c) If the Treasurer invests money of the Trust Fund, the Treasurer shall credit the interest or other income from the investment to the appropriate account of the Trust Fund.

- (a) (1) There is a Board of Trustees for the Trust Fund consisting of 15 members.
 - (2) Of the 15 members:
 - (i) The 5 ex officio voting members shall be:
 - The Comptroller of the Treasury;
- 2. The Secretary of Natural Resources or a designee of the Secretary;
- The Secretary of Human Resources or a designee of the Secretary;
- 4. The Secretary of Transportation or a designee of the Secretary; and
- 5. The Secretary of Budget and Fiscal Planning or a designee of the Secretary.
- (ii) The 6 voting members appointed by the Governor shall be:
 - 1. 2 members from the public;
 - 2. 1 member representing the utility industry; and
 - 3. 3 members of local government appointed in the following manner:
