[(d)] (F) The Administration shall adopt rules and regulations that, for the 12-month period beginning on October 1, 1983, and for each subsequent 12-month period, establish specific goals as to the maximum number of children who will remain in foster care for more than 2 years.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

(Senate Bill 246)

Board of Supervisors of Elections - Prince George's County

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code

2-1.

(a) (1) [The] EXCEPT IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE Governor shall appoint biennially in each county of the State and
