AN ACT concerning

State Merit System - Baltimore City Sheriff's Office

FOR the purpose of including certain employees of the Sheriff's Office of Baltimore City in the State Merit System; and making this Act an emergency measure.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 64A - Merit System
Section 9E
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1983 Replacement Volume and 1986 Supplement)

Preamble

WHEREAS, It was the intent of the Maryland General Assembly that all employees of the Sheriff's office in Baltimore City were to be transferred to the classified service by Section 4A of Chapter 109 of the Laws of Maryland of 1986; and

WHEREAS, Three employees in the positions of Court Secretary I and Account Clerk II were determined not to have been transferred to the classified service; and

WHEREAS, It was the intent of the Maryland General Assembly that these three employees in the positions of Court Secretary I and Account Clerk II were to have been transferred to the classified service; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
